We are seeking to appoint an experienced and talented church organist and accompanist to work with our new Director of Music to help us go from strength to strength as we re-emerge from the pandemic and look to the future. As a eucharistic Anglican parish church we offer the full range of liturgical and seasonal worship including a once-a-month all-age communion with keyboard and other musicians.

With one main service every Sunday, plus occasional other services and events, and Friday evening choir rehearsals (the organist is not required to attend all rehearsals) this role will suit someone who is looking for a containable part-time position working with a Director of Music in a well organised and friendly church.

We have a two-manual J W Walker and Sons organ (completely redesigned, refurbished and extended in 2016) and an SATB choir and music group.

Remuneration is £2000 per annum and additional fees are payable for occasional offices. The organ is available for private lessons, subject to our safeguarding and other procedures being fully adhered to.

The person appointed will require a DBS check and to complete safeguarding training.
